

SPECTATOR SAFETY



Thank you for spectating at Kennards Hire Rally Australia. For the safety of yourself, competitors and officials, we ask you to follow these simple rules on the following pages –

Do's and Don't's of rally spectating

- Stand only in a safe place
 - Stand back from the road
 - Stand on the high side of the road
 - Keep behind walls or fences
 - Keep clear of rally signs
 - Keep clear of prohibited areas
 - Pay attention at all times
 - Sit back from the edge of the road
 - Avoid blocking escape routes
 - Expect the unexpected
 - Listen for approaching cars
 - Leave your pets at home
 - UAV's / Drones / RPA's are not permitted at Rally Australia
 - Leave yourself room to move quickly
 - Try to keep behind something solid
 - Keep children under STRICT supervision
 - Do not stand on or cross the road after car '00' has passed - even if there are no cars for a time - there may have been a delay
 - After the last competition car, the Sweep car with flashing lights passes, indicating that the course is now open and it is safe to leave
 - Take your rubbish with you
 - Help the Marshals run a safe Stage
- Please follow Rally Official's instructions; otherwise, the Stage will be stopped**

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the event, you agree:

Motor Sport Activities are inherently dangerous recreational activities and there is significant risk of injury, disability or death.

If you do not wish to be exposed to such risks, then you should not attend at or participate in Motor Sport Activities.

WARNING: If you participate in these activities your rights to sue the supplier under the **Competition and Consumer Act 2010** if you are killed or injured because the activities were not supplied with due care and skill or were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in or on this page.

In exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Motor Sport Activities, **you agree:**

- to **release** the Confederation of Australia Motor Sport Ltd (**CAMS**) and the **Entities*** to the extent that any or all of them are providing Recreational Services from all liability for:
 - a) your **death**;
 - b) any **physical or mental injury** (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
 - c) the contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a **disease**;
 - d) the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other **condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs**:
 - i. that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to you or the community; or
 - ii. that may result in harm or disadvantage to you or the community, howsoever arising from your participation in or attendance at the Motor Sport Activities;
- to indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified CAMS and each of the Entities to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and
- to attend at or participate in the Motor Sport Activities at your own risk.

NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in or on this page, does not apply if your death or injury is due to reckless conduct on the supplier's part. "Reckless Conduct" means conduct where the supplier of the recreational services is aware, or should reasonably have been aware, of a significant risk that the conduct could result in personal injury to another person and engages in the conduct despite the risk and without adequate justification. See section 139A of the Competition and Consumer Act 2010.

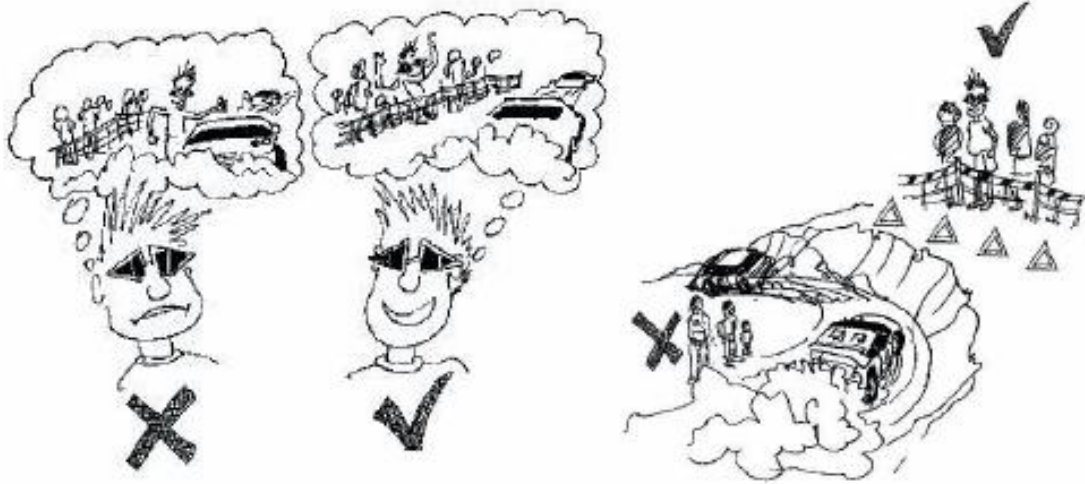
